RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Only one team is allowed from each University.

B. Only women student can participate in the competition.

C. Each team must consist of three participants and one team manager.

1. Prime Minister: To highlight the stand of her team and present a logical argument FOR the motion (if Prime Minister of Govt.) or AGAINST the motion (If Prime Minister of Opposition).

2. President: To further highlight and bring new arguments into the debate.

3. Whip: To oppose the points of the opponents completely through logic and Reasoning.

D. This competition consists four rounds as mentioned below:

ROUND 1 - PRELIMINARY ROUND

ROUND 2 - QUARTER FINAL ROUND

ROUND 3 - SEMI FINAL ROUND

ROUND 4 - GRAND FINALE

FORMAT OF ROUNDS:

Round 1 - Preliminary:

a. Each team will receive one bill for discussion.

The Prime Minister: 2 Minutes each

The President: 3 Minutes each

The Whip: 3 Minutes each

b. The bills for Preliminary Parliamentary Debate Round will be allocated during the Team Managers Meet. Allocation of Government and Opposition will be allocated by draw of lots. Draw of Lots will be done during the Team Manager's Meet.

Round 2 - Quarter Final:

a. 20 teams will be selected from Preliminary round for Quarter finale.

b. 10 teams of different Universities will be in Government and 10 Universities in Opposition will be selected by the draw of lot.

c. In this round each team (One speaker from each team) will be given 3 minutes to speak on the selected bill.

d. Bill will be announced by 24 hours before the parliamentary session.

e. 05 Teams from the Government and 05 teams from the Opposition will be shortlisted for the semifinal round (Round 3).

Round 3 - Semi Final:

a. 10 teams will be selected from the Quarter Final round for the Semi Final round and it will be a parliamentary debate round where 2 teams will face off each other and pair will be declared by the speaker of the house.

- b. 2 minutes will be given to each member of both the teams i.e. Government & Opposition.
- c. 3 minutes will be given for the Direct Interjection.
- d. After 15 minutes, remaining teams will be given 10 minutes for the Questions & Answers.
- e. Teams will choose the house for the questions; whether they ask question to the Government house or the Opposition house on the bill.
- f. On the basis of quality & impression of the question & answer; speaker will give bonus marks to the teams.
- g. Remaining teams will compete for the fourth position for all rounds.
- h. Sequence of the question will be based on either buzzer system or by given sequence of speaker.
- i. Team with the third highest marks will be the third position winner.

Important Instructions for Round 3:

- A coin toss will be held between the two teams. The winner of the coin toss will decide whether to be the Government or The Opposition.
- The Prime Minister of the Government will pick a motion from the raffle box randomly.
- The Government will speak FOR the motion and The Opposition AGAINST the motion.
- The First Speaker will be The Prime Minister of the Government.
- The Second Speaker will be The Prime Minister of the Opposition.
- The Third Speaker will be The President of the Government.
- The Fourth Speaker will be The President of the Opposition.
- The Fifth Speaker will be The Whip of the Government.
- The Sixth Speaker will be The Whip of the Opposition.
- The Judges will judge both teams on the basis of their Content, Logic and Presentation skills.
- The two best teams with the highest points will win the Semi Final and will head to The Grand Finale round.

Round 4- Final Round:

- a. In the Final round, the same pattern of parliamentary debate will be followed as earlier, with the addition of Question & Answer round by The Panellists (by other remaining teams from Semi Final round).
- b. The winners of the Final Round will be the Overall Champion of the AIU National Women Students Parliament.
- c. The other team will become the First Runner Up.
- d. Remaining teams will also get the chance to put forward their points; one point will be awarded for each (Marks will be given by Speaker of the house and Jury Panel only).
- e. From remaining teams, the team with the highest marks on the basis of the questions will get the consolation prize.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

- Only Bonafide, full time student, who is enrolled for a degree or post graduate degree or diploma course which is of a minimum duration of one academic year and whose examination is conducted by the University or college affiliated to university subsequent to passing the 12th class examination are eligible to participate.
- Students of open Universities shall be considered to be Bonafide students and shall be eligible to participate provided they fulfil other conditions.
- Only students, who are less than 25 years of age on the 1st day of July of current academic year, can participate. There is no minimum age of participation.
- A student shall not be allowed to represent more than one University during a single academic year
- Provisional admission to a course of a University or college shall not make the student eligible to represent the University / Institution.
- A student employed on full time basis shall not be eligible to participate.
- In case of a student migrating from one University to another his / her migration case will be considered eligible, only after his/her admission in the new University is regularized and he/she is admitted as a Bonafide student by the new University / Institution.
- AIU subscription fee is mandatory for participation in AIU Youth Affairs programmes by Universities / Institutions.
- Identity Cards with photographs signed by the appropriate authorities by the respective University should be carried by the participants.

STRENGTH OF EACH TEAM:

- Each team must consist of three members.
- Each Team shall be led by one Team Manager.

IDENTITY CARD:

Identity Cards with photographs signed by the appropriate authorities by the respective University should be carried by the participants.

UNIVERSITY FLAGS:

The Team Manager shall have to deposit his / her (one) University flags with the host University.

TRAVEL PLAN:

Teams are advised to reach Centurion University, Paralakhemundi Campus at the latest by 07:00 PM of 1st April 2025 and may plan exit after 10:00 PM of 4th April 2025.

TRAVELLING EXPENSES:

The participating University will have to bear the travelling expenses.

FOOD:

Food shall be provided by the Host University. Meals will be provided from lunch one day before the start of the event and till lunch of the next day of the valedictory ceremony.

BOARDING & LODGING:

Free board and lodging would be provided to the participating teams during the event. Participating troupes from the Universities could be housed as guests in student's hostels.

Accommodation will be provided from the night one day before the start of the event and till the next morning of the valedictory ceremony.

REGISTRATION / PARTICIPATION FEE:

Each participant (03) including team manager (01) will be required to deposit registration fee @ Rs. 2500/- per participant with the organizing university during registration.

DISCIPLINE:

- If the behaviour of any contingent is found contrary to the objectives of the event, the host University may take suitable action against members concerned and an individual / team be debarred from participation in the future AIU Events for three years under intimation to AIU.
- The consumption of liquor / intoxication, eve teasing, influencing the adjudicators, indecent behaviour inside the campus and venue is strictly prohibited. Those violating this clause shall be liable to disciplinary action which may be to the extent of debarring the concerned University Team Official from participation in the Inter University AIU Events for a period as may be determined by the AIU Cultural Committee.
- No official or any member University shall go to press on any controversial issue.

DISQUALIFICATION FOR VIOLATION OF ELIGIBILITY RULES:

Any disqualification of a participant on ground of ineligibility will result in the automatic debarring of the team for that academic year.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the AIU Events entirely at their own risk. Neither the host nor AIU will be responsible for any unfortunate circumstances.

JUDGMENT AND APPEALS:

- The decision of the judges appointed for different events shall be final. It is expected that their judgment will be respected.
- In case of any dissatisfaction, the matter may be referred to the Jury of Appeals. The Protest, if any, should be lodged with the Convener of the Competition within one hour of the end of the competition.
- No protest shall be entertained on matters regarding judgment. Protests can be entertained on matters related to violation of rules or improper conduct of the contest. There will be a protest fee of INR 1000/- (One thousand) only. This fee will not be refunded unless the protest has been upheld by the Jury of Appeals.
- No appeal shall lie against the decision of the Jury of Appeals.
